

**Covid-19 Considerations:** For the remainder of the summer we plan to continue with one worship service each Sunday, beginning at 10:00 am. Though we don't currently have Sunday School or Nursery, we welcome all children to join us for worship, as you see fit.

There are a number of important ways to prepare for our gathering together:

- Remember to humbly prefer others.
- If you are symptomatic, or knowingly exposed to Covid-19, please stay home.
- If you have underlying health issues that make you more vulnerable, please stay home.
- For those who gather:
  - **MASKS: For those 5 years old and older, with some exceptions, Gov. Evers has issued a mandate through September 28 to wear masks when indoors at public places (children between 2 and 5 are encouraged but not mandated). We can remove masks when eating (i.e. Communion). Individuals speaking from the platform can remove masks to speak or sing.**
  - Please be diligent in washing hands, covering coughs, etc. Hand sanitizer is available on Round Table in Narthex.
  - For the time being, we will refrain from shaking hands and giving hugs.
  - We will do our best to maintain 6' distancing. We have spread out chairs to allow more space between rows.
  - We will do our best to keep doors ajar, weather-permitting.
- No offering plates will be passed. Please look for "Giving Box" on Round Table.
- We will have the Lord's Table, but plates will not be passed.
- Children's Activity Books will not be available. We ask Parents to provide what you think is best to help your children be attentive.
- We will thoroughly clean between services.
